The Advanced Photo System, also called APS, is an analogue photography system based on a hybrid technology film format (chemical image and magnetic information) launched in 1996.

It was marketed by Eastman Kodak under the name Advantix, by Fujifilm as Nexia, by AgfaPhoto GmbH as Futura and by Konica as Centuria.

Kodak ceased production of its Advantix film in 2004.

The film is 24 mm wide and can have three image formats:

- H for "High definition" (11.89x6.5in.; aspect ratio 16: 9; print 4×7in.

- P for "Panoramic" (11.89x3.74in.; aspect ratio 3: 1; print 4×11in.
