FERRANIA LEATHER BAG for CONDOR cameras



Characteristics and functions

Leather case marked Ferrania, intended for use with **Condor** cameras; adapted with long leather shoulder strap.

The shoulder strap is made up of two distinct parts: the one fixed to the lower part of the bag, adjustable, measures about 27 inces at maximum extension and about 20 at the minimum (adjustment in 5 holes); while the second one allows a further extension of about 3 feet - in this case the adjustment is possible on three holes with a decrease on the maximum length equal to 3.54 inces. On the bottom of the bag there is, on the right, a hole about 3/8" in diameter. which allows viewing of the camera frame, while the screw fixing the camera to the bag is located at the opposite end (using the same thread used to attach the camera to the stand). In turn, this screw is threaded to allow the camera, complete with bag, to be fixed to the stand.

On the upper part of the bag, an automatic "female" is fixed at the back which allows to close the case by fixing it to an automatic "male" positioned in the center of the back of the lower half of the bag.
