Characteristics and functions

Camera Folding, the N.1 Pocket Kodak Series II uses Roll-film type 120 films and provides 6x9cm images. (2 $\frac{1}{4}$ "x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ "). The No. 1 Poket Kodak was produced between 1922 and 1931. All Kodak Pocket cameras have the door to use the 120 'Autograph' Roll-Film films produced by Kodak between 1914 and 1934.

This camera mounts a lens Anastigmat 108mm./ f.7, 7. The "Diomatic 0" shutter has six settings: B, T 1/10 1/25 1/50 and 1 / 100s. that are set by turning the small wheel with the small metal arrow as a reference. The cursor below the lens allows you to select the correct exposure time according to the set aperture and ambient light conditions: very cloudy, cloudy, hazy sun and bright sun. To open the bellows door it is sufficient to raise the chromed lever - which also serves as a support foot - and, raise the side levers. The chrome-plated lever on the left serves to arm the shutter,

the one on the right for shooting. The magnifying viewfinder can be rotated 90 $^{\circ}$ for shooting with a horizontal camera. There are two holes for using the tripod: one is located on the base of the camera, the other is on the bellows door and is used for vertical camera shooting.
