Characteristics and functions

The Sankyo Super CM300 is a Super 8 cassette film camera.

This camera has compact dimensions and low weight. It has a Sankyo 9-30mm zoom lens. with a ratio of 1: 3.3. The zoom movement can be performed electrically by means of the "W" and "T" buttons located on the right side of the camera. The advancement of the film is obtained by acting on the trigger and the shooting speed is 18 frames per second. It is possible to carry out the single shot using a flexible shutter to be screwed into the special hole located on the left side.

Power is supplied by 4 AA 1.5v batteries housed in the foldable handle.
