

ZEISS IKON Flash IKOBLITZ 730



Characteristics and functions

Flash for bulb lamps, Osram XM1 type, produced by Zeiss Ikon in Stuttgart in the mid-50s.

The ivory-colored plastic body encloses the folded dish and the synchro-flash cable.

The foot of the flash is lowered by pressing the red back button.

To eject the used light bulb, press the green back button.

The dish is unfolded (or closed) by acting on the red, striped plastic wheel that protrudes on both sides of the flash body.

The power supply is provided by a 22.5v battery.

Weight 3.56oz. (Battery not included).

Measurements: - Flash closed. Height 3.66in. Width 2.95. Depth 1.18in.

- The open reflector measures 3.78in. in diameter.
