





Tokyo Tower

La tour de Tokyo

Torre de Tokio

Built in prefabricated steel and reaching a height of 1,092 ft. (333m), this iconic structure has been one of the city's most popular attractions since its completion in 1958. As well as transmitting Tokyo's TV and radio stations signals, instruments at the top of the tower also monitor air conditions above the crowded city.

En acier préfabriqué, cette structure emblématique de 333 m de haut est l'une des attractions les plus populaires de la ville depuis son achèvement en 1958. Non seulement les instruments situés au sommet de la tour transmettent les signaux des stations de télévision et de radio de Tokyo, mais ils surveillent également la qualité de l'air au-dessus de la ville bondée.

Construida en acero prefabricado y con una altura de 333 m, esta llamativa estructura es una de las atracciones más populares de la ciudad desde que se erigió en 1958. Además de transmitir las señales de las emisoras de televisión y radio de Tokio, los instrumentos instalados en el extremo superior de la torre monitorean también las condiciones ambientales de la abarrotada ciudad.







Mode Gakuen Cocoon Tower

Located in the Nishi-Shinjuku high-rise district, this 669 ft. (204 m) tall building is home to three colleges and over 10,000 students. Its distinctive curved shape, dark blue glass and crisscrossed web of white diagonal lines creates a nurturing environment for the students studying inside.

Ubicado en Nishi-shinjuku, un distrito de rascacielos, este edificio de 204 m de altura aloja tres universidades y admite más de 10,000 estudiantes. Su característica forma curva, su revestimiento de vidrio azul oscuro y su entramado de diagonales blancas entrecruzadas crean un acogedor espacio para los estudiantes que aprenden en su interior.

Chidorigafuchi Park

The park is a narrow path that runs alongside the moat of the city's Imperial Palace. Many locals and tourists flock to the area in early Spring to witness the spectacular cherry blossoms during the brief hanami or flower viewing season.

TOKYO SKYTREE

TOKYO SKYTREE is the new symbol of the city of Tokyo. Though ultra-modern in both its appearance and construction, the architecture of TOKYO SKYTREE is similar to the classical design of the traditional 5-story Japanese pagoda. Opened to the public in May 2012, TOKYO SKYTREE is the tallest free-standing tower in the world, rising 2,080 ft. (634m)

TOKYO SKYTREE est le nouveau symbole de la ville de Tokyo. Bien qu'ultra-moderne dans son apparence et sa construction, l'architecture de TOKYO SKYTREE est similaire à la conception classique de la pagode japonaise traditionnelle de 5 étages. Ouverte au public en mai 2012, TOKYO SKYTREE est la plus haute tour autoportante du monde. Elle s'élève à 634 m.

La TOKYO SKYTREE es el nuevo símbolo de la ciudad de Tokio. A pesar del ultramoderno carácter tanto de su apariencia como de su construcción, la arquitectura de la TOKYO SKYTREE se asemeja al clásico diseño de una pagoda tradicional japonesa de 5 pisos. Abierta al público en mayo de 2012, la TOKYO SKYTREE es la torre autónoma más alta del mundo, elevándose hasta 634 m sobre el suelo.





Shibuya Crossing

Le carrefour de Shibuya

This iconic crossing at the heart of the Shibuya shopping district is the busiest in Japan (and possibly the world). At peak times up to 3000 people will cross the intersection, coming from several directions at once. In the evening, the area comes alive with the colorful lights of the neon signs and jumbo screens.

Ce carrefour emblématique au cœur du quartier commerçant de Shibuya est le plus fréquenté au Japon (et peut-être au monde). Aux heures de pointe, jusqu'à 3 000 personnes venant de plusieurs directions traversent ce carrefour. Le soir, l'endroit s'anime avec les lumières colorées des enseignes au néon et des écrans géants.

Este inconfundible cruce, ubicado en el corazón del distrito comercial de Shibuya, es el más transitado de Japón (y, posiblemente, del mundo). En hora pico, hasta 3000 personas cruzan la intersección en diferentes direcciones a la vez. Por la noche, la zona cobra vida gracias a las vistosas luces de los letreros de neón y las pantallas gigantes.






Overlooking Tokyo Bay and officially known as the Tokyo International Exhibition Center, Tokyo Big Sight attracts over 16 million visitors each year. Its most striking feature is the 190 ft. (58m) tall glass and titanium conference tower shaped like an inverted pyramid.

Surplombant la baie de Tokyo et officiellement connu sous le nom de Tokyo International Exhibition Center, le Tokyo Big Sight attire plus de 16 millions de visiteurs chaque année. Il se caractérise principalement par sa haute tour de 58 m en verre et titane, qui présente la forme d'une pyramide inversée.

Con vista a la bahía de Tokio y oficialmente conocido como Centro Internacional de Exposiciones de Tokio, el Tokyo Big Sight atrae a más de 16 millones de visitantes cada año. Su característica más llamativa es una gigantesca torre de conferencias de vidrio y titanio con una altura de 58 m y forma de pirámide invertida.








