Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Angle Finder II presented here is the second realization: the one that provides for the attachment with the bayonet is a 360 ° rotatable angle viewfinder that allows observation in the eyepiece when it is impossible to keep the camera at eye level. It should be inserted on the eyepiece by means of the small bayonet connection. To remove it, simply bring the red release button towards the viewfinder body and remove it from the bayonet of the eyepiece. It can be used with all SR series reflex cameras except for the first SR-2 which only have a threaded attachment. Once the Angle Finder has been inserted on the camera's eyepiece, the lens must be focused at infinity, then the eyepiece (part with ridged frame) is rotated to obtain maximum sharpness on the frosted glass of the camera. This viewfinder is built with a 45 ° mirror, without rectifying prism so the images are reversed right / left as happens in the Bioptics, such as for example in the Autocord. Weight 151g.
