Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Angle Finder V is a 360° rotatable angle viewfinder that allows observation in the eyepiece when it is impossible to keep the camera at eye level. It is slid onto the rectangular black plastic frame of the eyepiece. It can be used with all SLR cameras except for the first SR models equipped with a circular viewfinder. Once the Angle Finder has been inserted on the camera's eyepiece, the lens must be focused at infinity, then the eyepiece is calibrated for the dioptric compensation of ametropias with the possibility of between -4.50 and + 2.5 diopters by acting on the ring, just below the soft rubberized part of the viewfinder itself and observing the sharpness on the frosted glass of the SLR. This viewfinder will be renewed with the "Vn" version in 1981.
