Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Auto Bellows III was introduced in 1979. Incredibly refined and versatile, it features automatic aperture closure with both the lens in normal and reversed position. The adjustments of the movement of the lens and of the camera body are independent; the lens holder mount, which can be tilted and shifted, is fitted with a lock. There is a button for manual closure of the diaphragm (stop-down). This bellows, the best performing among those produced by Minolta, can be used with optics with focal lengths from 20 to 200mm. With the 50mm lens. it allows magnifications from 0.8x to 3.3x and from 1.4x to 3.8 with the objective in an inverted position. Since 1981 the Auto Bellows III have been marked with the new Minolta Logo with the rising sun in the "O".
