Characteristics and functions

This Super 8mm film reflex camera is equipped with an electric motor and a 9.5-38mm Minolta Rokkor zoom lens. f.1:1.8. electrically controlled with a minimum shooting distance of 1.2m. (4ft.). Exposure is completely automatic and the sensitivity of the introduced film is perceived by the camera according to the different profile of the cassette magazines that are introduced. The power supply is ensured by 4 1.5v type AA batteries contained in the foldable handle. The motor activation button is located under the lens, in front of the handle. The Minolta Autopak-8 D4 has a satin metal body and black faux leather. The zoom can be adjusted electrically by acting on the [TELE - WIDE] rocker button with the right hand or by manually rotating the zoom ring while holding the small striped metal handle that protrudes along the left side between the lens and the left hand. the camera body. The Autopak-8 D4 is equipped with an automatic CdS exposure meter. Shooting with a cadence of 18 or 24 frames per second are possible, or shooting with single shot (S.F. - Single Frame). The adjustment is made by acting on the satin metal knob located on the left side below the meter counter (which indicates the length of the film still to be exposed) and near the sinco-flash socket.
