

# MINOLTA BABY FLASH BC-1

## Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Baby Flash has a gray plastic body. The part that supports the dish is in satin-finished aluminum and acts as a lid for the compartment where the capacitor and the 22.5v battery are placed. To unlock the cover you have to act on the small lever that you see just under the parabola near the flash shoe. The Baby Flash BC-1 can be used with 3 types of bulb bulbs: Standard, M2 and AG. The foldable metal parabola has only one position of use, so the concentration of the flash is not variable. In the center is the seat where to insert the foot of the light bulb. The gray sync cable for connecting with the camera comes out of the plastic body, on the right side. On the back we find the mount for fixing the parabola to the body of the flash, the lever for ejecting the bulb used, the Minolta logo and the words "Made in Japan". Power is supplied by a 22.5v battery (Maxwell BL-MV15 type or equivalent).  
Weight 96g., Battery and lamp excluded.  
Dimensions with parabola closed: width 46mm .; height 95mm .; depth 47mm.
