Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Baby Flash BC-III has a very small gray plastic body that allows it to be easily adapted to Minolta 16 micro cameras. The metal part that acts as a parabola is folded on the front side of the flash body during transport. The gray cover with the inscription "Baby BC-III" can be removed by acting on the small chromed lever located near the foot of the flash. In the upper part, dark gray in color, there is the wording "Minolta". The condenser and the battery are located in the compartment below. On the back side there is the guide number and distance scale. Near the foot of the flash you will find the inscription "Made in Japan". The Baby Flash BC-III uses bulb type AG-1 and AG-1B bulbs. The gray sync cable for connecting with the camera comes out of the plastic body on the left side. The red light bulb is inserted on the terminal of the cable to check the efficiency of the battery. Power is supplied by a 15v battery. (type Eveready # 504 or equivalent).

Weight 60g., Battery and lamp excluded. Dimensions with parabola closed: width 38mm .; height 59mm .; depth 23mm.
