Characteristics and functions

This case, made of brown hard leather, is the typical ready-to-bag made up of two separable parts. The camera is fixed to the bag by means of the large chrome screw located under the bottom of the case, on the far left. The separation and removal of the upper cap is allowed by the presence of two snaps on the back of the bag. Another opening located in the center of the back of the lower part of the bag serves to observe the memo disc of the sensitivity of the film used which is placed in the center of the back of the camera. The wording "Made in Japan" also appears on the back of the case, heatengraved. At the center of the front protuberance there is a chromed disc which in turn has a brown leather disc inside with hot engraved "minolta". The bag has a thin leather handle instead of the classic adjustable shoulder strap. The hooking system through two chromed metal loops placed on the sides of the lower part is the same as the shoulder strap. Weight 182q., Handle included. Height 115mm. Width 160mm. Depth 90mm.
