

MINOLTA CASE for A5 (1966)

Characteristics and functions

This case, made of black rigid leather, is the typical ready-to-bag made up of two separable parts. The camera is attached to the bag by means of the large chrome screw located under the bottom of the case in the center. The separation and removal of the upper cap is allowed by the presence of an automatic and a buttonhole both located on the back of the bag. On the back of the case the wording "Japan" appears, heat-engraved. At the center of the anterior protuberance there is the wording "minolta", hot engraved. The bag has a thin adjustable shoulder strap in black PVC. The hooking system by means of two chromed metal loops which are located on the sides of the lower part.

Weight 181g., Shoulder strap included. Height 98mm. Width 160mm. Depth 85mm.
