

MINOLTA CASE for ER (1963)

Characteristics and Functions

This case, made of hard brown leather, is the typical ready-to-bag made up of two separable parts. The interior is in hazelnut-colored velvet. The camera is attached to the bag by means of the large chrome screw located under the bottom of the case. The separation and removal of the upper cap is allowed by the presence of three snaps located on the back of the bag. At the center of the anterior protuberance the word "minolta" is hot engraved. The separation between the front protuberance and the upper shell is highlighted by a thin chrome molding. The bag has a brown leather shoulder strap, adjustable and attached to two chromed metal rings located in two metal frames integral with the case, positioned on the sides of the lower part. The two holes located in the immediate vicinity of the chromed frames of the shoulder strap are used to pass the rings located on the camera which in turn allow the attachment of the shoulder strap directly to the camera to be able to carry it even without a bag. On the back, at the bottom right, the words "Made in Japan" are hot-engraved.
