Characteristics and Functions

This case, made of black leather, has the look of a ready-made bag typical of reflex cameras. The bag has excellent rigidity suitable for high impact protection of the camera. The interior is in the finest blue velvet. The upper part is completely removable by means of an automatic and an asymmetrical eyelet located on the back of the case. The inside of the case, in the points where it fits between the shutter button and the flash shoe, is structured in such a way as to give maximum impact protection to everything on the camera shell. The two lateral flares of the upper part of the bag allow the passage of the camera shoulder strap. A large plastic screw placed on the back allows you to hold the camera by means of its nut screw. The wording "Japan" is hot engraved on the back of the bag. At the center of the front protuberance is the chrome plate: "minolta"
Weight 100g., Height 105mm. Width 138mm. Depth 80mm.

N.B. Unfortunately, for the production of leather bags and cases Minolta, in the seventies, used a combination of materials that, after years, proved to be inadequate, causing the leather part to detach from the bottom, cracking all the way to flaking, obtaining a bad result. aesthetic.
