Characteristics and Functions

This case, made of black leatherette with zip closure, is dedicated to Pocket Autopak and Pocket Pak cameras without electronic flash produced between 1973 and 1975 such as the "40", "50", "60", "70 "And the whole" 200 "series. On the underside we find a flap, with two snap fasteners, which is used to attach the case to the belt, at the waist, for transport. The word "minolta" is hot-engraved on the upper side. On the front part of the flap for carrying on the belt, between the snaps, the wording "JAPAN" is hot-engraved. The inside of the bag is in blue velvet. Inside the upper part there is a rigid support with grooves designed to contain the shutter button and the focus slider in order to prevent accidental breakage and above all to avoid triggering the shutter, inadvertently pressing the bag at the shutter button.
