

MINOLTA CASE for SR-T (1979)

Characteristics and Functions

This case is made of black leather with a textured surface and interior in burgundy velvet, it allows you to house the body with the 50/1.4, 50/1.7 or 50/2 lens. The front is detachable by means of the special pin that slides into an asymmetrical slot positioned on the back. On the bottom of the bag there is the chromed screw for attaching the camera using its own nut screw. A circular opening on the bottom of the bag allows you to move the "On-Off-B.C." without removing the camera from the case; a second opening allows you to press the clutch release button to recover the exposed film without removing the camera from the case. The "minolta" logo, in golden metal, is placed in the center of the front, while the words "JAPAN" and the symbol of leather goods production are hot-engraved on the caseback.
