Characteristics and Functions

This case is made of brown leather. The interior, of the upper and lower base, is covered in hazelnut-colored velvet. The strap for carrying by hand is fixed to the sides of the lower part of the bag with a hook that allows it to rotate freely. The opening is allowed by the two front snaps placed near the bottom. However, the two parts of the case are not completely separable as the upper part is riveted to the back of the lower one. At the center of the front overhang is hot-engraved the inscription "Minolta", while on the back is engraved the symbol of Minolta used in those years formed by a prism inserted in a plano-convex lens which has the inscription "CHIYOKO" inside. The large oval hole located in the center of the back is used to show the window of the numbering of the film and to move the relative cursor to cover / uncover the window itself. At the base of the case there is the large chrome screw that is used to fix the camera in the bag by means of the nut screw. Weight 145g. Length 148mm. Height 112mm. Thickness 53mm.
