Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Eyepiece Cup EC-1000 eyecup, like all accessories that are called "1000", is part of the very first contemporary production with the new Autofocus system presented by Minolta in 1985 with the introduction of the SLR, a world first "7000 AF". The Eyepiece Cup EC-1000 is a universal eyecup that can be adapted to many SLR AF bodies also of future production; it is mounted on the viewfinder frame as a sled and allows to eliminate the reflections of stray light that enter transversely into the eyepiece during observation in the viewfinder itself; it also allows softer contact by avoiding placing the rigid plastic frame of the viewfinder on the eyebrow arch. It is no longer necessary to lift the eyecup to open the back, as was the case with the EH-7. It is sold in a light blue and transparent dispenser pack.
