Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Eyepiece Hood EH-7 ocular shell is mounted on the viewfinder frame and allows you to eliminate reflections of stray light that enter transversely into the eyepiece during observation in the viewfinder itself; it also allows softer contact by avoiding placing the rigid plastic frame of the viewfinder on the eyebrow arch. This accessory is suitable for use with all SLRs of the Manualfocus system. It can also be adapted to the 5000 AF, 7000 AF and 9000 AF SLR cameras presented in 1985. Given its circular shape, to open the back of the camera, the EH-7 must first be extracted from its position of use. The Minolta Eyepiece Hood EH-7 was marketed in the early 1970s. In 1981 it was packaged in white cardboard boxes with the new Minolta logo with the rising sun in the "O"; in the 1990s it was sold in a light blue and transparent dispenser pack
