Characteristics and Functions

The Microscope Adapter II, derived from the previous Microscope Adapter (short type) introduced in 1958, allows you to use Minolta's Manualfocus SLR cameras in microscope photography.

The adapter consists of 4 parts: a chrome-plated ring with a Minolta bayonet to be inserted into the camera optics port, a barrel, a connection mount to be inserted into the microscope eyepiece mount which is then firmly fixed to the barrel of the camera. Microscope Adapter by means of the ribbed screw on the side (to the right of the barrel in the image), and a cylindrical accessory to be used as a lens hood by inserting it into the lower mount of the adapter and then into the eyepiece mount of the microscope.

Weight 217g. Dimensions: length 135mm., Maximum body diameter 49.5mm. (excluding locking screw).
