Characteristics and Functions

The Minolta Slide Copier AB III was introduced in 1979 as an optional accessory of the Auto Bellows III. This accessory allows the reproduction of 24x36mm slides. mounted on a 5x5 frame or in a strip using the two side spools as support. It should be applied to the front end of the Auto Bellows III or IV rail and connected to the thread of the mounted lens, using its bellows which, when closed, is stored in the rear mount. To open, press the two rectangular black plastic side buttons. The slides mounted in the frame are inserted in the rear slot, while those in film are inserted in the front part under the opal glass, opening the hinged frame in the lower part like a book. For a wide versatility of use and cutting of images, this accessory has a vertical shift of 7mm. upwards and 6mm. downwards, while the lateral movement has a translation to the right and to the left of 8,5mm. With the 50mm lens. mounted on the bellows, magnification ratios from 0.8x to 2.6x are obtained. Since 1981 the Slide Copier AB III have been marked with the new Minolta Logo with the rising sun in the "O". Weight 323g. Length 190mm.; width 48mm.; height 117mm.
