Characteristics and functions

The Minolta Slide Copy Unit AB I was presented in 1968, designed to be used with the Autobellows I, it must be used by applying it to the Focusing Rail AB I by means of the large screw placed at the end of the part triangular. The rear section of the bellows is connected to the circular mount where the connecting ring with a thread diameter compatible with that of the lens used is inserted. To replace the ring, loosen the rear ribbed screw. The bellows open by releasing the coupling pins from the side springs. The part relating to the actual player is used in two ways: the front one with opal plastic support opens like a book by acting on the upper clip and is used to pass the tape film centering the 24x36 in front of the rear opening; the large slot behind it is used to insert the slide mounted on a 5x5cm frame. To do this, you must first remove at least one of the two ribbon holder arms by acting on the corresponding grooved head screw placed along the upper edge of the Slide Copier mount. Lightweight and compact, this accessory, complete with side tape holder, weighs 238 grams.
