Characteristics and Functions

The Chinese Seagull has a long tradition of collaboration with Minolta having received from time to time the production of cameras now out of production. These cameras use the same mount as Minolta's MC-MD bayonet optics. This hard plastic cap, for Seagull Manualfocus SLR cameras is virtually identical to the Minolta of the '80s in the "New Logo - Type 2" edition; it is applied on the bayonet by rotating it in the same direction as the closing movement of the bayonet of the lenses on the camera mouth. There is a reference for the insertion on the bayonet of the SLR: a small arrow placed along the edge in the upper right quadrant. The word "SEAGULL" is found, in relief, in the center of the raised circular part. The edge has a large relief and is striped. Weight 12g. Diameter: 58mm. Height 13mm.
