With the introduction to the market of the new XI-240 film of the Advaced Photo System (APS), Minolta introduces the Vectis S-1 reflex camera and a new series of autofocus lenses with a new "V" bayonet.

The initial series of optics consists of 4 zoom lenses and a 50mm Marco. The 28-56mm is comparable to a 35-70mm in the 35mm format, it allows close-up shooting by means of the "Macro" function up to a minimum shooting distance of 35cm.

Three quarters of the lens are covered by a large gray rubber ring which is used to set the focal length; there are no distance scales and not even the relative ring, so with this lens it is only possible to focus with autofocus. All the data relating to the lens and its performance are silk-screened on a gold-colored band. A last black band bears the inscription: "28-56" and "MINOLTA". Supplied with circular black plastic lens hood with bayonet connection with three flanges.

The collimation signal with the ring nut of the camera optics is made up of a red plastic hemisphere.
