This classic 28mm f.1: 2.8 arrived on the market in 1985 when the Minolta 7000 AF was introduced. New is the study of the optical system which is carried out with the formula of 5 elements in 5 groups instead of 7 elements in 7 groups. This new formula makes the lens economical and light. The body of the lens is covered, in the central part, by a rubberized band with dense inclined lines (1st type). On the left is the Minolta logo with the "rising sun"; on the right, two lines show the indications: "AF Lens" and "28". The collimation signal with the ring nut of the camera optics is made up of a red plastic hemisphere.
