Inscription on the lens:

Minolta AF Zoom 35-70mm 1:4 (22) Ø49mm

The 35-70mm. in its first version, from 1985, it has the Macro function and the brightness remains constant at f.4. The optical system consists of 6 lenses in 6 groups. The body of the lens is covered, in the central part, by a rubber band with a dense inclined strip (1st type). The focus ring is heavily ribbed. On the left is the Minolta logo with the "rising sun"; on the right, two lines show the indications: "AF Lens" and "35-70". The distance scales, visible in the window, are painted in yellow the one in feet (ft) and in white the one in meters (m). To switch to the "Macro" function, move the chrome cursor forward and rotate the zoom ring to the position highlighted by the blue line. The magnification ratio is 1: 4. Also to exit the "Macro" function, the chrome cursor must be moved forward to unlock the ring from this position.

The collimation signal with the ring nut of the camera optics consists of a red plastic hemisphere.
