The Minolta AF 70-210 was introduced in 1985 with the first set of lenses that accompanied the new SLR autofocus: the Minolta AF 7000.

The body of the lens is covered, in the central part, by a rubber band with a dense inclined strip (1st type). The focus ring is wide and ribbed. The "Macro" position is set at the 210mm focal length. In the focus scales a blue line appears between 1.1mt. and 2,4mt. Which delimits the field of close-up shots.

The collimation signal with the ring nut of the camera optics is made up of a red plastic hemisphere.
