FLASHGUN #280



For use with 180, 190, and 195 only.

The #280 flashgun is entirely different from the #268.

It mounts to the side of the shutter housing, with alignment provided by an extra pin jack next to the PC outlet.

The reflector is rather small and is of the fanfold variety. The interesting part about this flash is that a spring-loaded rod presses against the camera body (the back part of the camera) so that the flashbulb socket moves in and out of the reflector as the camera is focused, thus altering the dispersion of the light depending on the distance to the subject.

Note: The #280 uses 2 AA batteries and AG1B bulbs
