

# POLAROID Land Camera Model 185 “Millenium”



<b>Year of construction:</b>	2000
<b>Film type:</b>	107 (B/W) – 108 (Color)
<b>Shutter:</b>	Copal leaf shutter, 1sec. - 1/500sec.
<b>Meter:</b>	CdS - Manual exposure. (either by conventional shutter/aperture settings, or by the EV system)
<b>Diaphragm:</b>	From f/3.8 to f/32
<b>Times:</b>	From 1sec. to 1/500sec. plus B and T.
<b>Lens:</b>	114mm f/3.8 - 4-elements Tominon Optical (glass)
<b>Synchronisation:</b>	M and X sync.
<b>Self-timer:</b>	Yes - ("V" setting on flash sync lever)
<b>Focusing:</b>	Unit focus; focus is controlled by pushing on either side of a sliding arm located near the base of the bellows struts.
<b>Characteristics:</b>	dual-window view/rangefinder similar in basic design to the Polaroid-made units found on the 'classic' pack cameras.
<b>Accessories:</b>	Lens cap. Tripod socket. Metal strap.
<b>Note:</b>	This is an all-new limited-edition camera being sold by Polaroid Japan, and has little in common with the other camera with this model number. Interestingly, this camera is essentially a re-badged NPC 195 and is made by NPC for Polaroid Japan.
<b>Estimated Production:</b>	Insufficient Data (over 10,000)
