

# POLAROID Land Camera Model AUTOMATIC 210



<b>Year of construction:</b>	1967-1969
<b>Film type:</b>	107 (B/W) – 108 (Color)
<b>Shutter:</b>	Electronic - Aperture-priority automatic exposure only
<b>Meter:</b>	CdS
<b>Diaphragm:</b>	From f/8.8 to f/42 - Lens aperture at 3000 ASA is fixed at f/42.
<b>Times:</b>	From 10sec. to 1/200sec
<b>Lens:</b>	114mm f/8.8 3-elements (plastic)
<b>Synchronisation:</b>	Has PC socket for flash; flashgun is clipped to the top of the camera.
<b>Self-timer:</b>	No
<b>Focusing:</b>	Unit focus; focus is controlled by pushing on either side of a sliding arm located near the base of the bellows struts. Manual focus scale is also visible in the finder.
<b>Characteristics:</b>	Rigid viewfinder with "image sizer" distance estimator instead of rangefinder. Finder has projected frame-lines and automatic parallax compensation. Settings for film speeds of 75 and 3000 ASA. Exposure compensation dial with range of -1/+2 stops ("Lighten/Darken" control).
<b>Accessories:</b>	Nylon carrying strap
<b>Note:</b>	Film speed selector is on top of shutter housing
<b>Estimated Production:</b>	Not completely determined (over 1,500,000)
