

# POLAROID Land Camera SX-70 Supercolor Autofocus



<b>Year of construction:</b>	1978
<b>Film type:</b>	Time Zero SX-70 (Color film only- 10 prints)
<b>Shutter:</b>	Electronic - Programmed automatic exposure
<b>Meter:</b>	CdS
<b>Diaphragm:</b>	From f/8 to f/22. Smaller apertures possible when flash is used
<b>Times:</b>	From 10sec. to 1/175sec
<b>Lens:</b>	116mm f/8 4-elements (glass)
<b>Synchronisation:</b>	Built-in Flashbar socket for flash. Accessory electronic flashes were also available. "fill-flash" capability (using Flashbars) Auto flash exposure based on focus distance. Max flash distance 20ft. (6 meters)
<b>Self-timer:</b>	No
<b>Focusing:</b>	Autofocus; uses Polaroid Sonar AF system. Minimum focus: 10.4 inches (25cm.); AF "preview" available before exposure is made. Full manual focus is also possible.
<b>Characteristics:</b>	SLR (Single-Lens Reflex) viewing and focusing. Low-light warning in viewfinder. Chrome-plated plastic body with genuine leather covering. Exposure compensation dial with range of -2/+2 stops ("Lighten/Darken" control).
<b>Accessories:</b>	Leather carrying case. Tripod socket and neck strap lugs.
<b>Note:</b>	The film cartridge also contains the battery for operating the camera.
